According to an old Island legend, if the lei floats back to shore, its owner will return to Lord Howe.

Swimming in the blue crystal waters of the Lagoon, "shooting" the long, rolling breakers, snorkling, aquaplaning, hiking, mountain climbing, bicycle riding and tennis give endless pleasures to charm away every hour.

Reefing is another popular pastime. At low tide, the visitor can explore the southernmost coral reef in the world. There is endless fascination fossicking in coral pools for shells, sea creatures and anemones that dwell around the reef. Glass-bottomed boats are also available.

The 30ft, cruiser "Viking II" is used for fishing, cruising, trips around the Island and visits to the Admiralty Islets, which abound in bird life. The amateur, as well as the ardent angler, can seek the thrill of catching big fish which can be seen in the clear tropical waters.

People of all age groups are catered for at "Leanda-Lei." Those who like a quiet, restful holiday can relax in this semi-tropical paradise, away from the noise and worry of the city, while for the "young at heart" there is a continuous round of entertainment.

Films are screened in the local hall twice a week and dances on other nights at the Bowling Club, R.S.L. or Hall.
