# Lord Howe Island

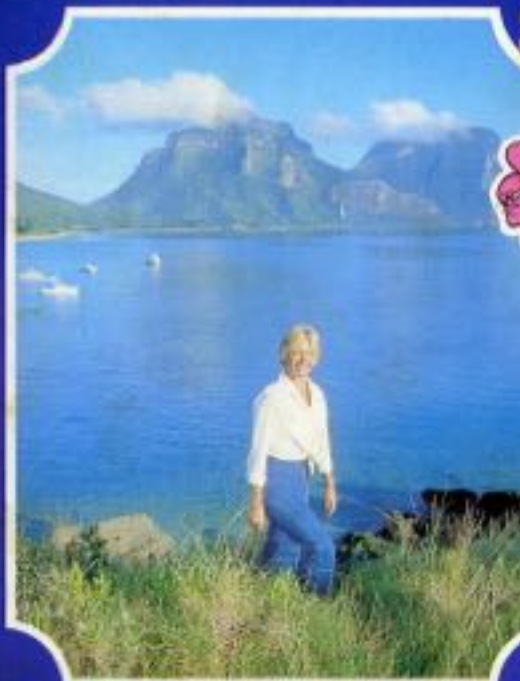
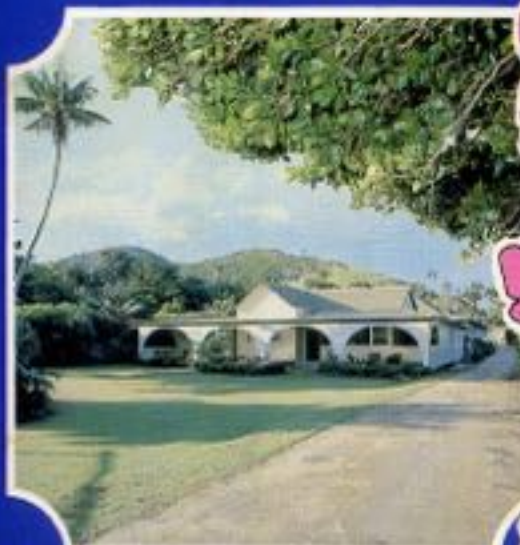
